We are currently reading The Stone Age boy. We will be learning to edit parts of the story with our own ideas. Then we will write our own journey stories using different types of sentences to make our writing more exciting. After this, we will be moving onto diary entries.	In Maths we have been focusing on telling the time on an analogue and digital clock, including 12 and 24 hour. This week we will be moving on to division, using informal and formal methods.	The children will be taking inspiration from the Stone Age to design and sculpt their own cave paintings using clay.	This half term we will be learning about rocks and fossils. The children will be investigating and comparing, which will help them to think scientifically.
