#### Rationale:

This learning has been chosen to engage the children and motivate them to have a go at writing, using their phonic knowledge and a range of quality texts based around different types of journeys. We will explore hot and cold places of the world, learning about the animals that live there.

### **Communication and language**

This term we will be looking at high quality texts around journeys, learning new vocabulary, and how to structure and re-tell stories.

### **Expressive Arts and design**

We will be using the scheme Charanga based around 'Rhythm in the way we walk and Banana rap, a reggae style and hip-hop rap. As musicians we will listen and appraise the style of music and continue to embed interrelated dimensions of music through a range of games and singing.

## Physical

This term we are learning how to travel in different ways and how to link some movements to make a sequence, both on and off apparatus.

### Personal social and emotional development.

We are continuing to work on the children seeing themselves as individuals and building on and constructing positive relationships, expressing their feelings, while considering the feelings of others.

### Knowledge of the world

We will be learning how to draw information from a simple map, exploring the natural world around us and looking at animals and their habitats. We will also begin to describe what we can see, hear and feel.

KASE Our curriculum is designed to ensure the children build their knowledge whilst having opportunities to develop important attributes like teamwork and empathy. We plan for a clear progression of skills and provide a wealth of experiences to further their engagement and understanding. We therefore call this our KASE curriculum.

### **Literacy**

We will continue developing phonic knowledge through our daily RWI sessions. We will practise forming lower case letters correctly, blending sounds in order to read and write CVC words and simple sentences.

### **Mathematics**

In Maths we will continue linking numerals to their cardinal value, counting beyond 10, and automatically recall number bonds with numbers 0-5. We will also be looking at 2D and 3D shapes.
