#### **Free School Meals**

If you are in receipt of benefits, your children may be entitled to free school meals. This means that you do not pay for meals and get help with other school costs such as trips, after-school clubs and uniform.

This is different to Universal Free School Meals where all children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to free school meals but this alone does not entitle them to the other benefits.

Please contact the office for a confidential conversation if you think you may be entitled to these benefits.

#### Paying for Trips

We have an increasing number of parents who are choosing not to pay for school trips. We are reaching the point where some of the trips will no longer be viable and the school budget cannot carry the cost. We are asking you to consider the benefits of trips for the children's learning. They fit into the curriculum and the Teachers plan them carefully to give the children enriched experiences. These do come at a cost though and this is why we ask for your contributions. Whilst we acknowledge that it is voluntary whether or not you contribute, we feel that we should let you know that trips will be at risk if contributions do not significantly increase. A massive thank you to those parents who always pay for every trip.
