I picked up on a very alarming BBC news story over the weekend. The 'Kik' chat app, has been involved in over 1100 child sexual abuse cases in the last 5 years. The Majority of police forces across the UK, reported that the app has been involved in investigations around grooming, sexual exploitation and indecent images. The app is popular with young people, but has many anonymous accounts and is easy to sign up for using false details.

I would strongly advise against children using the app. But, if you are aware that your child does use it or talk about it, I would advise that you look carefully at the app and how they are using it and decide if it is appropriate for them.
