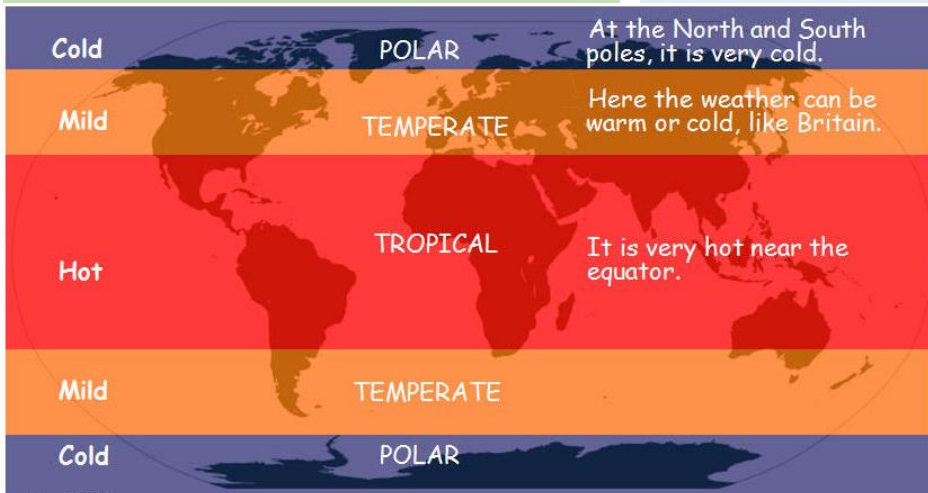
Geography – Continents and Climate Zones

A climate zone describes a part of the Earth's **climate** which can be defined by the **average temperatures** and **rainfall**.

There are **three** main climate zones:

- Tropical
- Temperate
- Polar

These can be further split into smaller zones. They describe the weather that is likely to be seen in that place.

An Arctic **tundra** describes land that is very cold and windy where little grows because of the lack of nutrients.
