## Character

Which are the best words the author used to describe your character?

*Challenge: Can you invent a new character and write a description?*

Vocabulary: definition, meaning, inference, discuss, intonation.

## Computer Programmer

Create a character on screen and make it move.  
Can you give clear instructions?

*Challenge: What devices in your home need programming?*

Vocabulary: code.

## Entrepreneur

Do you know how many pence are in a pound?  
Can you add and subtract money using column methods?  
Can you multiply and share out amounts of money using your times tables?

*Challenge: Go shopping, read all the prices and pay with real money.*

Vocabulary: pound, pence, convert, change, problem solve, steps, tenths, hundredths.

## Scientists

Can you make something move and explain how?  
Can you discover why something is happening?  
What is a magnet and how does it work?

*Challenge: Visit a park and describe the forces you use.*

Vocabulary: push, pull, gravity, repel, attract, compare, fair test.

## Toy Manufacturer

Can you link parts together?  
How can you make them move?

*Challenge: Design and make your own puppet.*

Vocabulary: lever, linkage, joint.
