On Tuesday, the Reception children went to Perdiswell Primary School, for a Superhero music festival. There were lots of other schools there too.


The children enjoyed singing, dancing and playing their instruments that we made in class. We also took part in a Superhero workout!

On a warm Wednesday, with the sun shining and a glorious blue sky, the children in Year 6 walked to Worcester Rowing Club to compete in the popular annual Bell-boating Regatta. The regatta, organised by five time Olympian Andy Train, had over 10 schools and 50 crews competing. In teams of 10, the children competed in timed heats throughout the morning. Crews from Oldbury Park managed three first places and several second and third places (out of five). No crews finished outside the top three places. In the afternoon, the teams were sorted into 'finals' based on their times from the morning, with the six fastest teams competing in the 'A' final which was the last race of the day. Teams from Oldbury Park finished in the top half with two teams making the top 20 fastest teams. Oldbury 'B' competed in the 'A' final and finished a credible fifth place (out of six), meaning overall that they were fifth out of over 50 – a great achievement. Once again, a sporting team from Oldbury Park competed with a positive attitude and excellent sportsmanship. Importantly, the children enjoyed some excellent exercise and were out in the fresh air.
