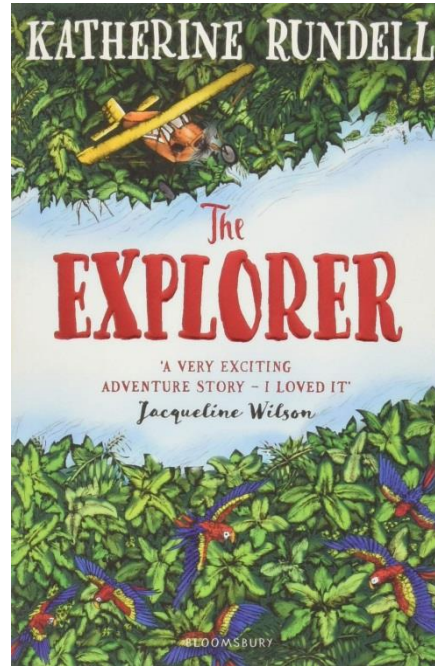
Our key text!
