

WRITE A FACT FILE

Research an element of space study which interests you and write a fact file about it.

Remember to use interesting fonts for your headings, add colourful pictures and informative diagrams (these may need labels).

SPACE TIMELINE

Discover some key events in space history and complete a timeline to show when they happened. Add pictures and explanations to make it as informative as possible.

SPACE ARTWORK

Create a stunning picture of space art—you could choose pencil crayons, felt tips, pastels or paints (whatever you have!).

KEY SPACE CONCEPTS YOU COULD BASE THESE TASKS ON

Day and night; seasons; phases of the moon; order of the planets; shape and size of Earth, moon and sun; gravity; missions and notable events; famous astronauts and astronomy.

DESIGN TECHNOLOGY

Build a model of a space shuttle, re-create the Moon landing or perhaps build your own model space station.

You could even use Star Wars or Star Trek as an inspiration for this.

CREATIVE WRITING

Imagine what it would be like to travel into space.

Produce a creative piece of writing exploring this idea. This could take the form of a setting description, a space adventure story, an astronaut's diary, a newspaper report or an email home.

SCIENCE

Create a page from a Science information book (text book) to explain a key space concept using text and diagrams. Show you can use the appropriate vocabulary (Talk like a Scientist!).
